

**City of Dexter  
Minutes  
October 2, 2023**

The regular meeting of the Dexter City Council was held on Monday, October 2, 2023 at 7:00 p.m. at the Dexter city hall. Council members present: Mayor Justin Forthun and council members Casey Erwin, Tim Taylor and Diane O'Connor. Christian Padilla absent. Others present: Minnesota House Representative Patricia Mueller, Gary Schroeder and Natalie Carroll.

Mayor Forthun brought the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.

Muller updated council on the latest news from the last legislative session. Topics included the new family and medial leave bill that was passed, the legalizing of the cannabis bill, and some aids that are available to both the city and county. The council thanked Mueller for her attendance and information that she shared.

Motion by O'Connor and second by Taylor to approve the October bills and to accept the September financial statements and minutes as presented. All yeas. Motion carried.

Motion by Erwin and second by O'Connor to approve the 2023 liquor license renewal to the Oasis Bar & Grill. All yeas. Motion carried.

Council reviewed delinquent water and sewer accounts. Motion by O'Connor and second by Erwin to send shut off notices to the following accounts: Shay Nold, Hunter Schultz and Gary Rech. All yeas. Motion carried.

Mayor Forthun informed council that he had spoken with Matt Rahlf regarding the Conditions that were discussed at the last council meeting. The conditions will be discussed at the public hearing which will be held on Monday, October 9<sup>th</sup>.

Erwin informed council that the city would be receiving a public safety grant in December in the amount of \$14,397.00. Erwin asked if council would designate the funds from the grant to the Fire Department. Council said they would discuss it once funds were received.

Motion by O'Connor and second by Erwin to adjourn he meeting. All yeas. Motion carried.
