

**City of Dexter
Minutes
March 2, 2026**

The regular meeting of the Dexter City Council was held on Monday, March 2, 2026 at 7:00 p.m. at the Dexter city hall. Council members present: Acting mayor Casey Erwin and council members Tim Taylor and Diane O'Connor. Mayor Justin Forthun and council member Christian Padilla absent. Others present: Gary Schroeder and Natalie Carroll.

Erwin brought the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.

Motion by O'Connor and second by Taylor to approve the February minutes and financial statements and to pay the March bills as presented. All yeas. Motion carried.

Council reviewed the specs for the tower reconstruction project prepared by KLM Engineering. Motion by O'Connor and second by Taylor to approve the specifications for bids as presented by KLM with the exception to remove the submersible mixer from the alternate bid. All yeas. Motion carried.

O'Connor said she had received complaints of junk and trailer storage and buildings being moved in without permits located at 133 North Main Street. Motion by O'Connor and second by Taylor to authorize the city clerk to issue an ordinance violation letter to the property owner. All yeas. Motion carried.

Clerk informed council that she was contacted the Mower County Highway Department regarding electronic speed limit signs. The county is willing to cost share in providing 2 signs for the city. Motion by Taylor and second by O'Connor to approve the cost share of approximately \$2000 per sign. All yeas. Motion carried. The county will provide the installation and maintenance of the signs.

Motion by Taylor and second by O'Connor to adjourn the meeting. All yeas. Motion carried.
